MANAGEMENT GOT BBC A 20% CUT

Do you remember when senior BBC management told us they would consult staff and unions before making any agreement with government over the BBC licence fee? Well, they didn't. Instead they caved into a rushed backroom deal with the government.

Did you hear them say that this was a strong deal? Well, in return for a CPI link to the licence fee, the BBC has agreed to give away 20% of their income to support government welfare policy in providing free TV licences to those aged over 75.

Did they assure you that "this agreement means we can continue to be a world-class creative organisation"? The cost of providing free licences to the over 75s will initially be around £600m per year and rising to over £700m by 2021 with the BBC looking at a net loss of at least £300m per year.

This shoddy deal, if unchallenged, will leave the BBC unrecognisable so do something about it!
